



Pastor's Desk

On June 29 and 30, our Masses will feature the readings and music for the Feast of the Precious Blood. This annual tradition, observed for the feast day on July 1, is a cherished part of our liturgical calendar. For this Sunday's Pastor's Desk Deacon Rusty Baldwin shares a reflection on Precious Blood Spirituality.

Symbols

The spirituality of the Missionaries of the Precious Blood, according to Fr. Schreiter, C.PP.S., can be summed up in four symbols: the Covenant, the Cross, the Cup, and the Paschal Lamb. These symbols

are not simply reminders of how God has worked in the past, they also carry a vision for the future, sealed in the Blood of Christ.

The Cross

I'll focus on just one of these rich symbols, the Cross. Precious Blood spirituality considers the Cross in a unique way. It invites us to join Our Lord on the Cross to see and experience the world he came to save as he did. To learn how true power is found in the helplessness and the pain of that Victim on the cross. From the Cross, we see the cast-offs of society, those God loves and wants to consecrate in Christ's blood; we experience every reproach Our Lord suffered. In the vulnerability that the Cross so starkly signifies we come to understand how God sees us and our world: a world so precious to Him yet deeply wounded in so many ways.

May our prayer be that, through His Precious Blood, we too might become channels of His grace to the world.



Court Rules USCCB & Catholic Orgs Can't Be Forced to Pay for Abortions

A federal court in Louisiana on [June 17th] ruled that an agency of the Biden administration cannot force the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) and other Catholic organizations to pay for their employees' abortions. [The] Equal Employment Opportunity Commission (EEOC) sought to use its interpretation of the Pregnant Workers Fairness Act (PWFA) to mandate that Catholic employers cover abortions, contrary to their religious beliefs. The <u>order</u> from the U.S. District Court for the Western District of Louisiana ruled that the "EEOC has exceeded its statutory authority to implement the PWFA." "[I]n doing so, [the EEOC] both unlawfully expropriated the authority of Congress and encroached upon the sovereignty of the [plaintiffs]," the court order stated.

Becket Law, the law firm that represented the plaintiffs, <u>noted</u> that the "ruling protects the [USCCB] and several other Catholic ministries from the [abortion-accommodation] mandate while the case is ongoing." "The states of Louisiana and Mississippi had filed a parallel lawsuit before the same court, and employers in those states were also protected by the ruling," Becket indicated. "The federal government has 60 days to appeal the decision." Becket counsel Laura Wolk Slavis <u>stated</u>: "The EEOC twisted a law protecting expecting mothers and their babies and coopted the workplaces of over 130 million Americans to support abortion." "That is an abuse of power," Wolk Slavis emphasized. "[N]o one should have to choose between their conscience and protecting pregnant women. Banning employers nationwide from affirming life is unacceptable and unlawful." She went on the call the ruling "an important step in ensuring that American workplaces can be free to continue serving their communities consistent with their beliefs."

- support pregnancy resource centers with our time or financial resources


