Ohio's recently passed abortion amendment (Issue 1) was cleverly crafted as a two-part strategy. First, the amendment used vague language appealing to *reproductive rights*, and avoiding any specificity that might have been objectionable to most voters. Once the amendment was passed, the strategy turned to implementation of an extreme and specific abortion regime to be defined through court cases. However, this second part of the strategy is far from certain because our courts and legislators still have considerable authority over how abortion is permitted in Ohio.

Since the passage of Issue 1, cases have been filed, with more anticipated, to overturn all legal controls on abortion.

As expected, the Ohio Supreme Court had no choice but to strike down Ohio's 6-week heartbeat law that would have greatly limited abortion. And just recently, an Ohio Appeals Court enjoined Ohio's 24-hour waiting period. But the Ohio Supreme Court will now have to finally rule on whether the waiting period is a reasonable safeguard to prevent coerced abortions. We can expect that every Ohio law affecting abortion will be challenged including laws on parental consent for minors, safety regulations for abortion facilities, and disposal of the remains of aborted babies. Also under attack will be our constitutional free speech and religious liberty rights to oppose abortion.

In their 2024 Respect Life month statement, our bishops have just told us: *[fifty years of virtually unlimited abortion has tragically created a national mindset where many Americans have become comfortable with some amount of abortion....Given this challenge, the U.S. bishops have affirmed that, while it is important to address all the ways in which human life is threatened, abortion remains our pre-eminent priority as it directly attacks our most vulnerable brothers and sisters, destroying more than a million lives each year in our country alone.]*

In this election we will choose three justices of the Ohio Supreme Court, many lower court judges, as well as senators and representatives in the Ohio Legislature. Faithful Catholics must take the time to learn about every candidate on the ballot and where they stand on sanctity of life issues, and must be sure to vote every down-ballot office. You can access many online pro-life resources that offer candidate information and comparisons. Using a neutral search engine like *Brave.com* with search terms such as *ohio pro-life vote 2024*, look for recent links from trustworthy, faith-based sources. Please also reach out and discuss candidates with Respect Life Group representatives and your fellow parishioners. Issue 1 was not the last word on abortion in Ohio---our vote this year matters greatly!

The Health Ministries Team is once again recruiting parishioners to be trained or re-certified in CPR and Automated External Defibrillators (AEDs) use for our churches.

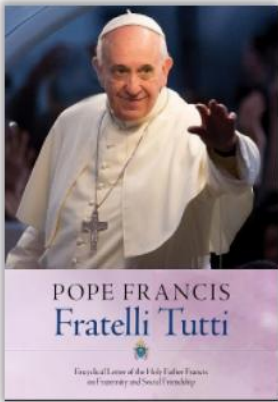

Notes from Emmanuel's Choir Loft

Today's Offertory hymn, "Abide with Me," was written in 1820 by Henry Francis Lyte. We sing this text to its usual tune "Eventide," written by William Henry Monk. Reportedly, Mrs. Monk claimed that he wrote it after they watched a sunset; others (less poetically) remembered that he composed it during a committee meeting. Regardless, this hymn was St. Theresa of Calcutta's favorite hymn; it reminds us poignantly in this autumn season that the Lord *changeth not; that ill has no weight, and tears no bitterness if He abides with us.*

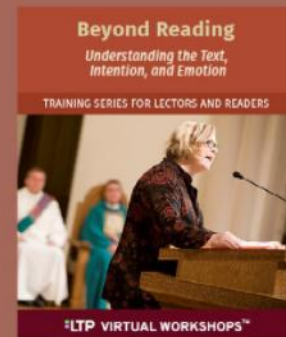
