


Walk with Mary this Lent

A New Nativity for Generations to Come

Fundraiser Beginning for a New Emmanuel Nativity Set!

Our Nativity set at Emmanuel is beautiful but it is, in fact, different sets that have been combined over the years and at more than 40 years old, is showing its age. This year three fingers on Baby Jesus' left hand broke off and one of the kings is no longer usable at all. Other pieces are becoming more and more brittle and fragile. To this end, we are starting a fundraiser so that we can have a new Nativity ready for Christmas 2025. The new Nativity will have all the same figures with the addition (given enough donations) of an elephant and an elephant driver!

The new Nativity will be from the Demetz Art Studio of Italy. The Demetz Art Studio provided the stunning lifesize nativity set for St. Patrick's Cathedral in New York. Our Nativity will be the same scale as our current set (with 30" figures) so that it will fit in the same space we use every year on the Sacred Heart of Jesus side of the sanctuary. Figures will be hand-painted and made of sturdy fiberglass. Fiberglass is more durable than our current ceramic set which means it will last for many, many years. Additionally, the figures will be individually packaged and stored in boxes with form fitting foam to protect them in storage and while moving them back and forth from the basement.

Total Cost \$29,400

A display with photos of the individual pieces is currently in the back area of the church with an itemized list of costs. The total cost of the Nativity as proposed is \$29,400. A price increase is expected in August so we hope to order soon!

After all Masses on Feb. 22 and 23, members of our Conference will be at the doors of church with Simply Give cards to take to Meijer and purchase on March 1. If you are not a Meijer shopper, you may donate to these members, who will purchase for you. Cards are always available at the entrance of church and at the checkout lanes at Meier Englewood.

FILL THE HOUSE

Imagine finally finding affordable housing after staying in the SVDP shelter with your children, only to have nothing but the clothes you brought with you. Each week, we receive up to 100 calls for help with rent, utilities, and basic necessities. During Home Visits, we often find families in empty apartments without even a bed, chair, or kitchen supplies. Thanks to your generous donations, our Fill the House Ministry provides essential household items to help these families start fresh. Our supplies are now low, and we need your help again. We are requesting new pillows, lamps, kitchen and bathroom waste cans, laundry baskets, plastic hangers, everyday dishes (no china), and twin-size sheet sets. Donations can be left in the bins at St. Rita, St. Paul, and Precious Blood. Thank you for your kindness and generosity!

BY THE NUMBERS

During the third quarter of 2024, we assisted our neighbors in need with:

- Over \$14,897.60 in rental assistance given to keep 53 families in their homes;
- More than \$18,254.32 in assistance given in order to keep 114 families' utilities and water on
- Over \$2,389.00 worth of furniture given to 11 families in order to improve our neighbors' quality
 of life

We also gave food to people from 232 households, feeding 218 seniors, 302 adults and 228 children through our food pantry.

During the fourth quarter of 2024, we assisted our neighbors in need with:

- Over \$15,394.15 in rental assistance given to keep 53 families in their homes;
- More than \$19,090.08 in assistance given in order to keep 112 families' utilities and water on
- Over \$1,676.00 worth of furniture given to 9 families in order to improve our neighbors' quality of life We also gave food to people from 312 households, feeding 232 seniors, 443 adults and 277 children through our food pantry.


