

#### That Sounds Different...

#### @Precious Blood, St. Paul, and St. Rita

Have you noticed a change in some of the acclamations we sing at Mass? Well, there's a reason. Different liturgical seasons bring about changes in ritual music. Some of the changes include Mass settings, which include the Gloria (omitted during Lent and Advent-except for the Feast of the Immaculate Conception), Penitential Litany, Gospel Acclamations, and the Eucharistic Acclamations. Musicians typically switch Mass settings and other acclamations when there is a change in liturgical seasons. Just as meteorological seasons have a different feel, so too, does the liturgical seasons. For example, some



acclamations during Lent and Advent may be composed in a minor key, which has a somber or melancholy feeling. In Ordinary Time (particularly the summer months), I may select a Mass setting composed in a major key. The liturgical cycles (ABC) may also have an influence when selecting service music. So if you notice a change in our sung acclamations, it's likely there was a change in liturgical season or cycle.

#### **Notes from Emmanuel's Choir Loft**

Because we are so blessed as to have Precious Blood priests here, today's offertory hymn seems especially fitting. "Let Thy Blood in Mercy Poured" comes to us from the Eastern Orthodox tradition via its translator, John Brownlie (1857-1925), a Scottish Presbyterian and author of several works on hymns. Our tune is a few centuries older, attributed to Johann Cruger. Note the musical tension in first half of the refrain as we sing of His passion ("Thou didst give Thyself for me"), which resolves itself in the final phrase when we respond to His mercy ("Now I give myself to Thee").

Keep them healthy in mind and body, and never allow them to wander far away from you. May their kindness be rewarded with eternity. Amen."

By this time last year, we were almost through raising the walls of the Church building in Nkanchi village. I am glad to announce that the roofing was completed on December 14, 2024. The plastering is going on now, though slowly. Many students have received help with tuition and fees. I, therefore, render my sincere gratitude to you for your kindness, generosity, and love. You have continuously demonstrated your missionary spirit. St. Therese of Lisieux was considered a missionary even though she did not go anywhere to visit. She said, "I offer every step for some missionary who, far away, is exhausted by his work for souls; I offer my exhaustion to relieve his." Her prayers were efficacious. In the same way, your missionary spirit is effective as you continue to touch and change lives through KumboKids and Community. Thank you immensely for your great act of kindness.

Next year, on April 19, 2026, I will be 25 years as a priest. I hope to say one of my Thanksgiving Masses in this new Church, perhaps with some of you present. How wonderful and pleasant will that be? However, there is still a lot to be done in the Church to get it close to the finishing point: the ceiling, the plastering, which is ongoing, the pews, building the sanctuary, the flooring, the windows, the doors, the painting, the electricity, to finish the plumping work, and decorate the Church. At this juncture, I continue to solicit your financial support to bring the Church to the finishing level. We are also making some local contributions to augment some of the expenditures of the Church. If I come to you this often, it is because our need is great, and our means are limited, and most importantly, because of the love of God in you transmitted in helping others. With you, there is hope! Thank you.




